Hops

Hops vines have become increasingly popular in the floral industry. What used to be grown solely for brewing, are now making their way into the floral industry. One of the most experimental industries, wholesale florists are willing to try anything once. Hops vines have made a

successful start in the market and are continually expanding.

Tip: If you want the hop vines to stay fresh a little longer, it helps to cut a few inches off the bottom and stick them in a bucket of water. They will draw water and that will help them last longer

Hops vines are available now and cut as ordered. They come about 16' in length and are packed:

1 x 44" box

2 x 48" box
